PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND:

[May/16 – Sep/17] – Lemann Foundation: The biggest Brazilian Education NGO which is also the main advocate for the Brazilian National Standard of Learning (Base Nacional Comum – BNCC). Worked as BNCC implementation coordinator. Responsible for:

- **BNCC Implementation Coordinator:**
 - **Cooperation Cases:** Brazil has a cooperative education system, where states and municipalities are responsible for different levels of education. Knowing that working closely is important to maintain the curriculum coherence, I coordinated two cases of success in states with different contexts (Mato Grosso do Sul and Sergipe). These states developed a process to create a regional curriculum and this methodology has been used by many other states which want to follow their example;
 - **Support Program Advocate:** Knowing that many education systems would have difficult incorporating the BNCC into their curriculum, I advocated for MEC having a national program for implementing the BNCC. The program has its first version and it has been validated with states' and municipals' secretaries of education;
- **BNCC State Conferences Coordinator:** the state conferences were the events where educators were invited to discuss the 2nd draft of BNCC. I coordinated the national team who developed a standard methodology used by the local teams –one team of 3 to 5 people per state- and summarized the discussion of all events. I was also responsible for monitoring local teams' progress and report it to Ministry of education (MEC). Despite the fact that we have only 2 months to organize and execute all 27 events, they happened with no unforeseen event and they accomplished the deadline.

[May/15 – Mar/16] – São Paulo's State Department of Education (SEE-SP): Over 5,000 schools, 3.8 millions of students and 300 thousands of workers. Annual Budget in 2015: R\$28 billions.

- **IT and Evaluation Department:** Responsible for building a project governance model to ensure that all 72 projects would be prioritized and implemented;
- **Learning Focus ("Foco Aprendizagem"):** Online platform which presents a feedback regarding standardized tests to teachers and principals. Responsible for design the platform, manager the developers, and evaluate the results. After 1 semester, more than 4.000 schools have used the platform;
- **Who Misses Is Missed Project ("Quem Falta Faz Falta"):** Project focused in reducing the absences in school. Responsible for identifying children that should be called by a call center and to manage the call center. From the children called, over 50% raised their presence and didn't miss the year.

[Jul/10 – Feb/15] - Integration Consulting: Strategic Consultancy focused on implementable solutions. Founded in Brazil, in phase of global expansion, with offices in Latin America countries and London.

- Developed solutions and tools mainly in Supply Chain and Finance areas, with international experience.
