



Social Happenings



Professor [David Plank](#) hosted the monthly seminar series on U.S. Education Policy (in Comparison to Brazil). Emeritus Professor [David Stern](#) was this month's presenter (via video conference) on Career-Technical Education. This theme was chosen given the relevance of vocational education for the Reforma do Ensino Médio, currently underway in Brazil. Professor Stern is Emeritus Professor of Education at UC Berkeley whose research focuses on the relationship between education and work and on resource allocation in schools.



Visiting Scholar [Sabine Righetti](#) presented her research on "Higher education in Brazil: challenges and assessment" at the EDUC 404 course. The talk was based on her 15 years of experience covering this field as a Brazilian journalist specializing in education, her doctoral dissertation in the field, as well as the higher education data she has been collecting in Brazil.



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
